ADVISORY TO NGOs ON FOREIGN FUNDING

Do familiarise yourself with the Foreign Contribution (Regulation) Act 2010 and the Rules.

DO's

- Do refer **FAQs** to the the Home provided in web site Ministry at http://mha.nic.in/fcra.htm
- Do conduct due diligence about the foreign donor and the terms of grant, to see that no law is violated.
- Do check list of banned organisations.
- Accept foreign contribution duly if you are registered or if you have received prior permission from Government of India.
- 'foreign note that contribution' need foreign necessarily be in currency.
- Do note that money transferred by an FCRAregistered NGO may come within the definition 'foreign contribution'.
- Do furnish annual accounts within prescribed dateline.

approach Do not middlemen.

DON'Ts

- Do not deviate from the purpose of grant.
- Do not use ATM cards or debit cards for the foreign contribution account.
- mix foreign Do not contribution account with of domestic account receipts.
- Do not encourage 'cash' withdrawals, as every cash withdrawal can be suspect.
- invest foreign Do not mutual contribution in funds or other speculative investments.
- Do not transfer any foreign contribution to an NGO that is not registered under without prior FCRA, of the approval Government of India.
